Regular Meeting Minutes - February 13, 2017

The East Troy Community School District Board met in regular session on February 13, 2017. The meeting was called to order by President, Ted Zess at 6:04 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present were Martha Bresler, Dawn Buchholtz, and Ted Zess. and student representative Heather Nowatske. Dr. Christopher Hibner, Daphne Kohnke, administrators/supervisors, one community member, two staff members and one reporter. Ted Zess read the open meeting statement indicating that the meeting is open to the public as required by state statute and that notice of the meeting had been sent to the media and/or posted.

IV. APPROVAL OF AGENDA AS POSTED

A motion was made by Dawn Buchholz and seconded by Martha Bresler for approval of the agenda as posted. Motion carried unanimously.
