ABOUT THE PROJECT

Successful Referendum

In April 2015, a majority of district voters approved two referendum projects in the ETCSD. The projects at the high school include:

- relocating the main office to enhance security
- adding four new classrooms
- establishing a robotics and technology education addition
- creating a new band rehearsal room and a new fitness room
- enlarging some current classrooms
- renovating the technology education area, the choir room, the lecture hall, the locker rooms, and the main bathrooms
- > purchasing and installing a new energy management system

Saving approximately \$2 million for Taxpayers

The ETCSD recently locked \$20 million of its upcoming referendum debt for a better than expected 3.53% interest rate. The general obligation refunding bonds, which are dated and settled as of September 2, 2015 were bid and locked in mid-August. When the referendum costs were estimated last winter, a rate of 4.25% was anticipated. This savings of .72% in the interest rate is expected to save approximately \$400,000 to taxpayers in interest costs and \$1.6 million less in premium applied to interest over the life of the 20 year borrowing.
