
#### PREPARATION

# What will the Referendum Support?

If approved, the funds will help:



maintain programming and staffing



provide more predictability and stability to the district

# Tax Impact of an Approved Referendum

If approved by voters, the estimated school tax impact of the referendum would be \$1.40 per each \$1,000 of equalized value.



\$140 per year (\$11.67 per month) per \$100,000 in property value

The operational referendum will directly impact programming and services for our students.

## Why an Operational Referendum?

Unlike taxes paid to the State of WI, all referendum dollars stay in East Troy.

An operational referendum is necessary due to: continued lack of state funding per revenue limit, inflationary impacts, increasingly competitive markets, and one-time federal funds (ESSER) no longer being available to help sustain ongoing day-to-day operations.

## What has the District done to address the funding challenge?

#### **Cost Saving Measures**

In the last 16 years, the District has done the following budget balancing efforts:

- Employee benefit plan changes and reductions
- Moderate wage increases
- Gains in energy efficiency
- Restructuring and elimination of positions
- Applying for grants and gifts
- Refinancing debt
- Pre-paying debt to minimize interest costs in the long term
- Elimination of programs and services
- Deferred maintenance

#### **Controlled Tax Levy Increases**

 School taxes have gone up an average of 1.03% per year over the last nine years.

#### Federal One-Time Funds

- The district used the federal pandemic relief funding (commonly called ESSER) to address student and staff safety, HVAC, student learning, and operations. These funds were one-time, not ongoing, so they are no longer available.
- The district completed the high priority heating and ventilation project at the Middle School which was offset by one-time ESSER funds.

If you have already received your absentee ballot, please make sure you complete it, sign it, and mail it in or drop it off at your required location!




#### **Vote In Person - Know Your Polling Location**
