



# EARN CREDITS OVER THE SUMMER!

East Troy High School students may take advantage of summer school courses in order to earn credits during the summer of 2025. Wondering why you might want to earn credits during this summer? There are several reasons!

- Earning additional credits may allow you to graduate early in order to jump start college courses, work full time, begin trade school, or participate in an apprenticeship.
- Scheduling required credits over the summer may free up your schedule to take more exploratory electives during the Fall, Winter, or Spring trimesters.
- Fulfilling prerequisite courses over the summer may allow you to take Advanced or AP courses in the future.

## FOR-CREDIT SUMMER SCHOOL COURSES

**GRADE:** Current Freshmen, Sophomores, or Juniors.  
*Current 8th graders may sign up for Human Geography A*

**CREDIT:** 0.5

**GPA:** All courses will count towards overall GPA.

**PERIOD:** Mon-Thurs, 8:00AM - 12:00PM  
*\*Students must be available each day during the scheduled period in order to receive credits.*

**DATES:** June 16 - July 17  
*\*No classes on Thursday, July 3*

## HOW DO I SIGN UP?

If you have any further questions in regards to these courses, how they might align with your graduation requirements, and how to register, contact the ETHS Counseling Office.

**Parent permission is required prior to registering for any For-Credit course. The drop date for Creative Writing and Human Geography A is July 1st, while the drop date for Medical Terminology is July 30th.**

**Dropping any courses after the drop date will result in a "W" on the student transcript.**

**Per board policy 431, students may not exceed 3 absences for in-person For-Credit courses.**

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
