
Survey Summary






Overall District Satisfaction

(by municipality)




How does the District compare to others in the following areas?

(parents)






Perceived Quality of the District's Effect on Home Values






Satisfaction with District Communications

Would you use any of the following to communicate with the District?




Would you support pursuing a plan to add a swimming pool at the high school?


Would you support pursuing a plan to add an auditorium at the high school?




Would you support pursuing a partnership with the public library to build and develop shared facilities?




What advice would you offer the District regarding the best elementary school option at some point in the future?















Section V: Comment Theme Analysis



Comment Themes

- Some respondents feel the District should place more emphasis on the arts.
- Many recognize the District's financial challenge and encourage the District to do more with less given the slow economy.
- Taxes are perceived to be high and any tax increase will be difficult, especially on people with a fixed income.
- Non-parents would like to see communications improved .
- Many respondents feel a need for technology upgrades.
- Many respondents expressed a concern about overcrowded and/or outdated facilities.
- Many parents would like to see more advanced class offerings at the high school.
- Many respondents are very satisfied with the District in many areas, including excellent teachers and administrators.
