East Troy All Sports Booster Club recognizes its outstanding athletic tradition by inducting former Trojan competitors, coaches, teams, and distinguished athletic program contributors into the East Troy High School Athletic Hall of Fame.

### East Troy High School Athletic Hall of Fame Objectives:

- To recognize and honor outstanding competitors, coaches, teams, and contributors to East Troy High School who have excelled in athletics and/or made significant contributions to the sports programs.
- To display to current students and to community members the accomplishments of those individuals who have been instrumental in creating the outstanding Trojan tradition.
- To provide opportunities for students, former students, and community members to recognize and celebrate former East Troy High School competitors, coaches, and contributors on a yearly basis.
- To promote continued interest in the East Troy High School athletic program.

#### **Nomination Process:**

- Nominations must be submitted via the Hall of Fame Nomination Form. East Troy Athletic Hall of Fame Nomination Forms are available on the East Troy High School Athletic Website. Nominations are due by February 1st of each year (March 1st this first year). There are no restrictions on who may submit a nomination form.
- Nominees that are athletes must have graduated from East Troy High School at least ten years prior to nomination.
- Consideration may be given to a nominee's contributions to their profession and/or community, as well as other accomplishments following graduation from East Troy High School.
- There will be no restrictions on the minimum number of inductees annually, but will not exceed 7 individuals annually and one team every other year.

# Ceremony:

- The Hall of Fame Induction ceremony takes place each fall in September or October and is open to the public upon purchasing a ticket.
- Information regarding the Hall of Fame activities and event schedule is printed in the local newspaper and can be found on the school website and on social media posts.

#### **Athlete Nominee Criteria:**

- Graduate of East Troy High School, at least 10 years after graduation.
- Exceptional individual accomplishments within a sport or sports (e.g. all-conference selection, all-region selection, all-state selection, MVP, school record).
- Significant contributions made to the success of a team (e.g. team conference championship, regional championship, sectional championship, state championship, team school record).
- Strong moral character, and good citizenship throughout the athlete's life.
- Post-graduate participation and distinction in sports will be given consideration.

#### **Coach Nominee Criteria:**

- Coach in the East Troy Community School District who has achieved success and coaching distinctions.
- Excellence in coaching (e.g. record, conference championships, regional championships, sectional competitions, state competitions).
- Contributions to the positive development of students and demonstration of special care and concern for the development of student-athletes.
- Strong moral character and good citizenship while coaching and after retirement.

### **Contributor Nominee Criteria:**

- Individual who has made significant contributions to East Troy Community School District athletics in roles other than participation in or coaching a sport.
- Longevity of contributions of time and energy in support of East Troy Community School District athletics.
- Strong moral character and good citizenship.

# **Team Nominee Criteria:**

- Exceptional accomplishments as a team (e.g. sectional champions, state champions).
- Consistent display of strong team unity and commendable sportsmanship.
- 10 years after relevant sports season.
