Meeting Minutes

March 6, 2017

MEETING: Called to order by Vice President Mary Harding

NEW MEMBERS: No new members this month

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Dean Roberts motioned to approve the report. Mary seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Debbie Hodges motioned to approve the report. John Stockowitz and Rosemary Martin seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

DISBURSEMENTS: John presented a Request to Purchase for new bleachers for the Bret Miller gym. The request is for \$2500 per year for the next 4 years, totaling \$10,000. The delivered and installed price of the bleacher system is \$82,795 and the Music Boosters are being asked for the same \$10,000 donation. The bleachers will be installed on both sides (total of 757 seats), have handicap access, and 357 seats on the north side of the gym will have backs on them. If we agree and the Music Boosters do not, the seat backs will probably go away. This is still in the planning stages. Mary motioned to approve \$2500 for the next 4 years totaling \$10,000 for the bleachers from Goodson Furniture and Equipment. Debbie seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.
