MEETING: Called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Alisa Aleckson

SECRETARY'S MONTHLY REPORT: Debbie Hodges motioned to approve the February report. Alisa Aleckson seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Income for February consisted of \$3,462 in concessions and \$69 in Frank's receipts. Expenses for February consisted of \$1,286 for concessions supplies and \$1,750 for 2021 scholarships and \$300 for the ETHS athletics ad. The 2021 scholarships paid out in January were Emily Aleckson and Kiley Komperud. The scholarships paid out in February were Jordyn Gulig, Laci Cesar, and Abbi Bruce. Alisa Aleckson motioned to approve the report. Debbie Hodges seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

DISBURSEMENTS: There were no requests for money this month.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Website Updates
 - a. End of Year Banquet has been removed.
 - b. Club Purchases still needs to be updated.
2. Winter Concessions Openings: There are a few remaining openings for winter concessions.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. New Membership Chair: Thank you to Julie Kader for accepting the Concessions Chair position.
2. Winter Concessions Closing: Marolyn Komperud will move everything to the spring concessions stands.
3. Spring Concessions Opening/Filling Spots
 - a. Coordinators will be Casey Heimos for baseball, Rese Schreiber for softball, and TBD for track and soccer.
 - b. Signup Genius will be used for spring sports.
 - c. In between monthly meetings, on March 2, Marolyn Komperud suggested and Debbie Hodges motioned to increase prices for candy from \$1 to \$1.50, pizza from \$2.50 to \$3, cookies from \$0.50 to \$0.75 for 1 and \$1.25 to \$1.75 for 3. Alisa Aleckson seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.
 - d. Concessions pricing for profitability will be revisited at future meetings.
4. Spring Sports Meetings: Julie Kader will bring a schedule to the meetings for parents to sign up for concessions.
5. Stein's Volunteer Opportunity: Doug Beth presented a spring volunteer schedule for review. It

includes options for volunteering at three locations. Alisa Aleckson motioned for 50% of the funds for a session to be shared with any sports team that fills that session with their volunteers. Laura Cesar seconded. All in favor. Motion carried. Reid Oldenburg will put together a schedule to send to the coaches. Julie Kader suggested that we offer it to other clubs after the sports teams have signed up for dates.

6. Changing Membership Expectations: It was decided to keep the requirement the same for this coming year.
7. 2022 Scholarships/Committee: The senior scholarship meeting will be held the Monday after spring break. Reid will deliver the applications to the club.
8. Post Prom Committee Donation Request: The Post Prom donation of spirit wear has been made.
9. Senior Sports Banners: Some schools have banners up only on Senior Night, some don't display banners, some have banners up all season. Reid Oldenburg will ask other Athletic Directors what their schools do.
10. Streaming Sports: Every school does this differently. Some schools use Just A Game, YouTube, or NFHS. Just A Game and NFHS charge for the service and YouTube is free. Donating funds to the athletic program to subsidize this would be a way to support multiple sports.
11. Next Meeting: The next meeting will be held on Monday, April 4th at 7:00 p.m. at East Troy High School in Room 603.

Debbie Hodges motioned to adjourn. Marolyn Komperud seconded. The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
