3. Fundraising Ideas: Michelle Schaefer suggested a fundraising letter that was sent to families at another high school through Classmunity. Rosemary Martin suggested a raffle. Marolyn Komperud suggested including the Booster Club membership in the school registration process online. Pam mentioned that in-person parent meetings in the fall will help.
