EAST TROY COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION Regular Meeting Minutes – November 15, 2021

The East Troy Community School District Board met in regular session on November 15, 2021. The meeting was called to order by President Ted Zess at 6:01 p.m followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members also present were Bob Dignan, and Anna Janusz. Absent was Dale Ames and Steve Lambrechts. (Steve Lambrechts arrived at 7:00.)
