Dear ETCSD Families,

In preparation for the 2025 - 2026 school year, the East Troy Community School District will offer families two options for instructional delivery.

Option 1: In-person Instruction - We believe that the best place for students to learn is at school. In addition to academics, schools provide their learners with many services that cannot be easily replicated online including (but not limited to): social and emotional skill development, healthy meals, exercise, and mental health support.

Option 2: Rural Virtual Academy (RVA) - <u>RVA</u> offers a virtual learning experience for students in 4K - 12th grade. This option requires a full-year commitment and is recommended for students who are dedicated to the virtual learning platform. Because of the full-year commitment and upcoming deadlines, we wanted to ensure that all of our families have this information as soon as possible.

RVA might be right for your child/family if:

- You know that your child is successful at virtual learning and demonstrates the <u>characteristics of a successful</u> <u>virtual learner</u>
- You want the flexibility of being able to learn anywhere
- You have health related concerns for your child/family and how that relates to in-person learning

**Please note that students in 4K - 2nd grade who enroll in RVA must have an adult available to assist during virtual instruction.

The RVA enrollment application period for the 2025 - 2026 school year is now open and will close at 4:00pm on April 30th. Families who are interested in RVA must add their student's name to the <u>student/family interest list</u>. After completing the enrollment interest form, families will receive email updates with enrollment instructions. Please note that <u>returning RVA students</u> and their siblings are considered first for enrollment. If you plan to register for in-person instruction in East Troy, you do not need to do anything at this time. Annual registration for current students and families will be available in the summer of 2025 and more information will be coming in the months ahead.
