Regular Meeting Minutes – October 21, 2019

The East Troy Community School District Board met in regular session on October 21, 2019. The meeting was called to order by President Ted Zess at 6:03 p.m followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members also present were Tony Barrett, Bob Dignan, Jessica Fuchs and Steve Lambrechts. Also present were Dr. Christopher Hibner, Amy Foszpanczyk, Kathy Zwirgzdas, administrators/supervisors, Silas Heimos student representative, and two guests. Ted Zess read the open meeting statement indicating that the meeting is open to the public as required by state statute and that notice of the meeting had been sent to the media and/or posted.

IV. APPROVAL OF AGENDA AS POSTED

A motion was made by Jessica Fuchs and seconded by Steve Lambrechts for the approval of the agenda as posted. Motion carried unanimously.

V. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Jessica Fuchs and seconded by Bob Dignan to approve the minutes of the September 23, 2019 regular board meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

VI. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PER BOARD POLICY

Tim Griffin spoke on the potential referendum, stating we need to pass an operational referendum, need to do more with teacher salaries, and we need to get it on the ballet to give voters the opportunity to be involved.

VII. FINANCIAL REPORT

Bob Dignan made a motion to approve the September 2019 payments in the amount of \$1,847,752.75 and receipts in the amount of \$860,190.50 as reflected on the financial statements. Tony Barrett seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

A. <u>Setting of the 2019 Tax Levy and 2019-2020 District Budget:</u> Ted Zess made a motion to set the tax levy of Fund 10 \$13,232,666, the Fund 39 \$1,746,175, and the Fund 80 \$254,239 and prior year levy chargeback for uncollectible taxes of \$11,600 for a total tax levy of \$15,244,680, and

- approve the 19-20 original budget as presented. Jessica Fuchs seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Referenda planning toward development of possible referendum question: The Board asked for a few questions to be drafted, roughly between \$98 \$126 tax impacts, and outline what could be addressed with the funding: safety and security, maintenance projects, structural deficits, enhanced educational opportunities to encourage enrollment, or other.
- C. <u>Staffing recommendations</u>: Ted Zess made a motion to approve the replacement hire of Michelle Sievers for the diagnostic position. Jessica Fuchs seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
- D. <u>Health, Safety, and Nutritional course proposal:</u> Jessica Fuchs made a motion to approve the course. Bob Dignan seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
- E. <u>Curriculum change proposal related to Foundations of Early Childhood Education (dual credit program)</u>: Ted Zess made a motion to approve the change. Jessica Fuchs seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
